The November application date allows Waterski Wakeboard Sask to:

- use the results from the 2025 season when reviewing the applications
- hire and secure next season's team coach well in advance

- plan with the provincial coach for development if there is an opportunity to train out of province
- give the coaches and athletes a season plan based on the tournament schedule, especially if there are requirements for applying for National team opportunities
- plan next season's camps and book external coaches if necessary
- issue training cards amounts for each HP SaskFirst qualifying team member based on scores in each discipline and overall rankings
- give time for team members to work on fundraising to help with the costs for their training and competition fees
