



Junior Travelling Coach Waterski and Wakeboard Saskatchewan

The Participation Grassroots Traveling Junior Coach will be a trained and certified Waterski and Wakeboard Foundations coach, certified Level 2 boat driver, have valid First Aid and be available to carry out all necessary waterski and wakeboard activities for Waterski Wakeboard Sask (WSWSASK) during the last week of June, and the full months of July and August.

Expected roles:

- assist senior coach with on-site organization and instruction of towed water sport clinics throughout the period of the contract.
- arrange for safe storage and deliver the boat to the next Traveling Clinic site at the close of each preceding clinic with senior coach.
- collect membership forms at clinics and events.
- fill out the logbook daily and report weekly.
- be responsible with the senior coach for transporting, maintenance and overall care of the boat, as well as maintaining the truck and trailer during his or her term of contract.
- drive the WSWSask boat during clinics and events.
- promote all aspects of towed water sports programming to local clubs and promote SkiAbility, Women on the Water, and other such programs to offer to underrepresented athletes in towed watersports.
- assist in promoting WSWSask through active social media
- assist local clubs with technical requirements for events and tournaments
- assist senior coach with set up of sites for Travelling Clinics and provincials.
- junior coach will report to the Director Sport for All WSWSask.

Compensation - \$150-\$200/day for clinic delivery based on experience and WSWSask pay grid.
